

USSF 2010 Recert Update

Every year in order to recertify, a referee needs to get 5 hours of continuing education and pass the test.

It is getting those pesky 5 hours that is the problem. We put on 5 recert clinics in the Vancouver area every fall. We are strongly encouraged by the state to have all of the recerts done by then end of the calendar year. So, after Dec 31, if you have not attended one of the Recert clinics you will have to travel to get your hours. Oregon offers training hours – check the Oregon Referee Committee’s website.
